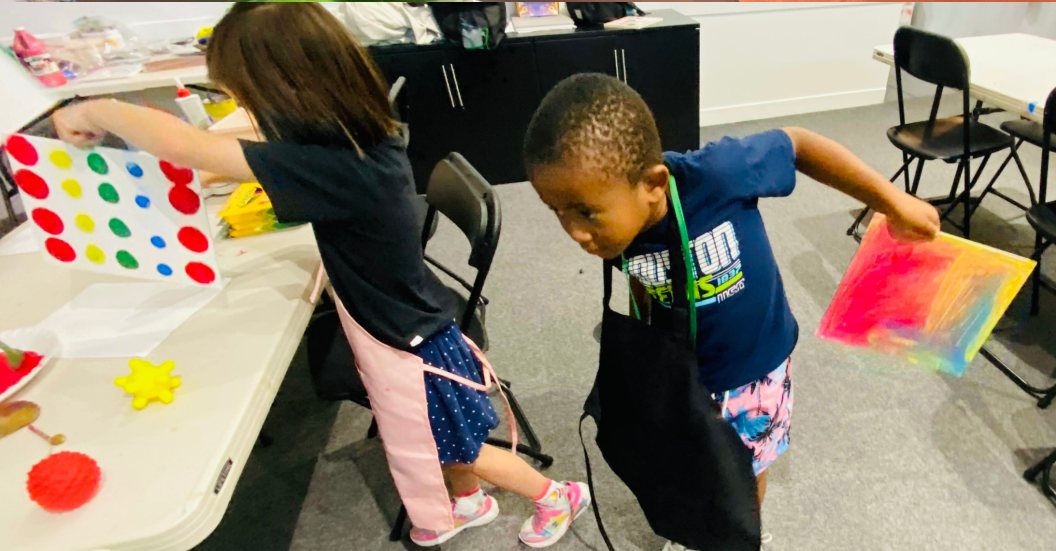

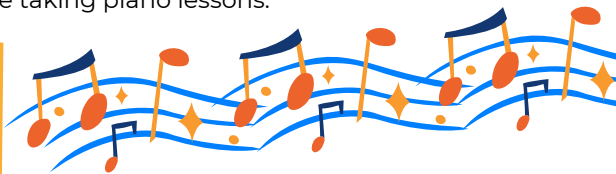

CREATIVE WRITING

Each week Creative Writing teacher will take students through a new prompt and cater for the ages that are present. Students will study a bit of writing, and then write their own, learning everything from sentence structure to slam poetry. For students who drop-in once they will have a chance to write and ask questions and share their words. Those students that drop-in frequently will wind up with a collection of inspirational words written by others and by themselves. Each week will also include a creative group activity to provide solutions for writer's blocks and help budding young (and young at heart) writers find camaraderie and team work even as they explore their own individual styles.



SPRING BREAK CAMP

Help your student enjoy their Spring Break by sending them to FAME Center's Fine Arts Camp. Students will have the chance to have fun with friends, meet new people, enjoy learning about visual and musical arts, and get inspired with creative activities all day long. FAME Center faculty will teach daily classes in the arts, and guide students in inspired ensemble play when they are not actively learning new skills.

FAME's camp runs from 9:00 AM - 4:00 PM, Mon-Thur. Students are asked to bring a snack and lunch. We also are offering the camp as a daily drop-in if your students isn't available the entire week.





PRIVATE LESSONS

FAME Center offers a free trial lesson for private lessons, for students of all ages, ability and means. All trial lessons are 30 minutes long.

Weekly private lessons are offered for 30, 45 or 60 minutes and can be hosted in-person at FAME Center or online via zoom. Instruction for some instruments and visual art available in Spanish and Mandarin!

Package lessons are available for those artists with more complicated schedules, prepping for a specific audition or event, or older artists that are just looking for a refresh.

Private lessons are offered for piano, voice, guitar, ukulele, violin, viola, cello, drums, saxophone, clarinet, flute, acting, creative writing, and visual art.
